

Vehicle Comparison on the Ferry

When selecting a vehicle for ferry transport, several factors must be considered—**size**, **weight**, and overall capacity are some of the most important. Each vehicle type presents specific **advantages** and **disadvantages** depending on the purpose of the **trip**.

The standard car is generally the **smallest** and **lightest** option **available**. It is **shorter** and **narrower** than any other vehicle type and is typically used for personal transportation. These vehicles are not only **easier** to manoeuvre and park, but also **more fuel-efficient** compared to larger alternatives.

In contrast, the large car is **longer**, **wider**, and can carry **more passengers**—up to nine in some cases. While it provides additional space and comfort, it is usually **less efficient** in terms of fuel consumption. Because of its size, it is not always the **most convenient** option for city driving or limited parking areas.

High cars, such as SUVs or vehicles equipped with roof racks, are **taller** than standard or large cars. **These are often chosen by drivers** who need to transport equipment or luggage on top of the vehicle. Although they offer **more vertical space**, they may **face** restrictions on certain ferries due to **height** limits.

Finally, the car with a trailer **represents** the **longest** and **heaviest** vehicle configuration allowed on the ferry. While it is ideal for **transporting** cargo or additional goods, it is also the **most challenging** to manoeuvre and requires more space both on the road and on board the ferry.
